Designed for wall or under-desk mounting, the panic transmitter sends a

repeating signal when activated until reset with a key. An LED indicator flashes periodically to indicate that the unit is in its triggered state. The unit is also available as a single-shot unit without a reset facility.

Multiple units can be used on a site, each sending its own unique identifier to the receiving devices, which could be pagers, fixed receivers with relay outputs, or a combination of both.
